For any stocks or bonds above the value of \$10,000.00:

(i) If the stocks or Bonds are against Jain Values, the Financial Adviser has the standing order to liquidate the stocks/bonds immediately as soon as they are transferred to the Jain Society.

(ii) If the stocks and bonds are not against Jain values, then the Financial Adviser will send an email to all the trustees with the details of the stocks/bonds donated to the Jain Society. Trustees will get back to the financial adviser within seven working days with the decision to hold or liquidate the stocks/bonds. The Financial adviser will liquidate or hold the received stocks/bonds as per the trustee's decision.

Swapna Ceremony Saturday, Sep. 15 - 1:30 PM

Swapna Ceremony will be celebrated in Eleanor Roosevelt High School -7601 Hanover Parkway Greenbelt, MD 20770 on Saturday Sep. 15, 2012. Swapna Ceremony will start at 1:30 PM, with a Lecture by Falguniben Zaveri followed by Swapna boli, Parnu, Aarti, and Mangal Divo.

During the Swapna ceremony, members will have the honor of carrying each Swapna to the beats of drums and music. Gheeboli will be performed for all the Swapna's, including Parnu, Aarti and Mangal Divo at the Swapna Ceremony.

If you are interested in taking the ghee boli for swapna 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, the minimum ghee boli for these swapnas will start with \$301. The minimum ghee boli for Swapnas 10 through 14 will start with \$501 and the minimum gheeboli for Lakshmiji will start at \$2001. A maximum of 10 families can join together for taking ghee boli for a Swapna.

The highest bidder amount will be announced in the hall and members will get an opportunity to bid further based on the highest amount. The

Swapna will be assigned to the highest boli bidder online or in the hall.

The Swapna ceremony program will be followed by **Swami Vatsalya Bhojan** (dinner). We are looking for members to sponsor the Swami Vatsalya Bhojan. The total expenses are around \$5501. Rules and Regulations for Overnight Stay at Jain Center

Members of our Jain Society will be allowed to stay overnight at the Jain Center during

programs scheduled at Jain Center, provided that they (1) sign and submit the Liability Release Form, (2) submit a proof of their medical insurance coverage, and (3) make a donation for overnight stay in the amount stated below. Non-members will not be allowed to stay overnight at the Jain Center unless they become member to take advantage of this privilege.

The donation amount for overnight stay shall be \$8 per night with a maximum of \$40 for a period of up to 8 days during Paryushan Parva, and \$50 for a stay of up to 10 nights during Das Lakshan Parva. This donation does not cover any food or medical expenses incurred during stay at Jain center. Donation for overnight stay at the Jain Center during other scheduled programs (e.g., Jain camp) will be decided by the Executive Committee.

Guest speakers or invitees getting honorarium from Jain Society for their services will be allowed to stay overnight at the Jain Center without any donation. They will be allowed to stay overnight at the Jain Center from one day prior to the commencement of the scheduled program until one day after the completion of the scheduled program.

Persons staying at the Jain Center shall maintain the facility in accordance to good safety and hygiene procedures. Prior to leaving the facility, all food (cooked or raw) must be removed, and trash must be taken out.
