Special General Body Meeting

Special general body meeting was held on November 1, 2009 to discuss the topic of building an authentic Jain temple, to discuss the course of actions needed, and to pass necessary resolutions required to go forward with the implementation of temple construction. Announcement of the meeting was sent out to all members with more than 15 days prior notice as required by the constitution. By overwhelming majority, the participating general body selected option of moving the Temple by purchasing land at a different suitable location and building an authentic temple and other facilities at the new location. Following the resolution, a proposal to authorize the Board of Trustees to implement the option and purchase a suitable land at a cost not to exceed \$1,250,000 (\$1,000,000 plus or minus 25%) was approved unanimously.

Temple Committee Report

Montgomery County special zoning restriction on our current facility has made construction of temple and other larger facilities at current location virtually impossible, so we need to move to a new location. As per resolution passed in special general body meeting on November 1 2009, the board of Trustees was granted authority to make a land purchase. The committee has identified three locations one in Montgomery County and two locations in Prince George County near the boundary of Montgomery County. We are assembling additional details relating to these three properties before we make final offer to acquire the property. We will need financial help from entire community to make this a successful effort. We will share more details as they become available.

Legislative Conference

Non-violence, the importance of relationship-building, and religious harmony, were key themes of the Federation of Jain Associations in North America's (JAINA) Legislative Conference held from October 6-7 in Washington, D.C. The themes of the two-day conference were Peace, Harmony and Non-Violence. The conference was supported by the American Jewish Committee (AJC) and the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (AAPI).

Attendees included nearly 70 JAINA executives, members from North America, and India. The conference was arranged by the JAINA Public Affairs Council chaired by Dr. Manoj Dharamsi. It was coordinated by Dr. Sushil Jain, First Vice President of JAINA; Dino Teppara, Director of Legislative Affairs

for AAPI; and Nissim B. Reuben, Program Director for Indian-Jewish American relations at the AJC. Dr. Jain is a retired U.S. Naval officer and Teppara served as a staff member to U.S.

Congressman Joe Wilson (SC-02) for seven years, including two years as his Chief of Staff and Counsel.

On October 6, the AJC welcomed JAINA executive members, who met with Mr. Michael Owen from the State Department (whose portfolio covers India, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and Bhutan), Adrienne C. Bory, India Desk Officer with the Bureau of South and Central Asian Affairs, and discussed the facilitation of visitors' visas to Jain monks, nuns, and artisans and the extension of the R visa. In the evening, during the reception at our Jain Center, director Gerald Krell presented clips of his documentary, "Three Faiths, One God", and provided a preview of his upcoming documentary on Asian religions.
